CONDITIONS OF COMPETITION

FORMAT: The 2010 Hampshire Hog will be decided over two rounds of 18 holes in accordance with the Rules of Golf as approved by the R&A Rules Limited and the Local Rules of North Hants Golf Club. The Hampshire Hog is a scratch stroke play competition.

ENTRY: Entry will be limited to 72 players. All entrants must conform to the Rules of Amateur Status as approved by R&A Rules Limited.

HANDICAP LIMIT: The handicap limit for entries is a Playing Handicap of 2. In the event of a competition being over subscribed then those players with the higher handicaps will be balloted out of the draw and placed in Exact Handicap order on the reserve list.

TEES: Tees in use will be the **WHITE** markers.

TIME OF STARTING - Rule 6-3a: If, in the absence of circumstances that warrant waiving the penalty of disqualification, as provided in Rule 33-7, the player who arrives at the starting point, ready to play, within 5 minutes of his starting time shall be penalised two strokes. If the player is more than 5 minutes late, the penalty shall be disqualification.

LOCAL RULES: The Local Rules applicable are as printed on the score card. Any changes from and additions to these Local Rules will be notified on the day.

DISTANCE-MEASURING DEVICES: For all play at this course a player may obtain distance information by using a device that measures distance only. If, during a round, a player uses a distance-measuring device that is designed to gauge or measure other conditions that might affect his play (e.g. gradient, wind speed, temperature, etc.), the player is in breach of Rule 14-3, for which the penalty is disqualification, regardless of whether any such additional function is actually used.

PACE OF PLAY: Each player is responsible for playing without undue delay. A strict pace of play policy will be operated.

PRIZES:

The Hampshire Hog to the player with the lowest 36 hole score.

The Hampshire Salver, presented by Hampshire, Isle of Wight & Channel Islands County Golf Union, to the player with the lowest 72 hole total from both the Selborne Salver and the Hampshire Hog.

Vouchers will be presented to the winner of the Hampshire Salver, the top 6 in the Hampshire Hog, and for the best score in each individual round of the Hampshire Hog. No competitor may take more than one voucher prize, but more than one trophy may be won.

THE HAMPSHIRE SALVER: Competitors who have also played in Blackmoor Golf Club's Selborne Salver competition held on Saturday 17th April 2010, may compete for The Hampshire Salver. This Trophy will be awarded for the best combined score over the 72 holes of both events. In the event of a tie for The Hampshire Salver, the trophy will be awarded on a count-back over the last 18,9,6,3 or final hole as may be necessary.

TIES: In the event of a tie for The Hampshire Hog, there will be a sudden death play-off over holes 1,2,5 & 9, but all other ties will be decided on the last 18,9,6,3 or final hole as may be necessary.

PRACTICE ROUND: Courtesy practice rounds are on either Sunday 11th April 2010 from 1.30pm, Thursday 15th April 2010 from 3pm or Friday 16th April 2010 from 12noon. Tee reservations should be made with the Professional Shop after 22nd March 2010. Competitors may play only one courtesy practice round. Only one ball may be played during the practice round.

COMMITTEE: The Hampshire Hog and the final 36 holes of the Hampshire Salver is organised by the Captain's Committee of North Hants Golf Club, which will rule on any dispute which may arise and its decision shall be final.
