## OPEN MIXED FOURSOMES

#### **CONDITIONS OF COMPETITION**

**FORMAT:** The 2010 Open Mixed Foursomes will be decided over two rounds of 18 holes in accordance with the Rules of Golf as approved by the R&A Rules Limited and in accordance with the Local Rules approved by North Hants Golf Club.

**HANDICAP LIMIT:** The combined playing handicap of both players must not exceed 34 with Gentlemen having a maximum playing handicap of 14 and Ladies having a maximum playing handicap of 24.

**TEES:** Tees in use will be the **WHITE** (SSS 71) and **RED** (SSS 73) markers.

**HANDICAP ALLOWANCE:** Pairs will receive half of their combined handicaps after the Ladies have added two allowance shots for the difference in the SSS.

**ORDER OF PLAY:** Gentlemen will drive the even holes in the morning and then the odd holes in the afternoon.

**ENTRY:** Entry will be limited to 36 pairs.

**ENTRANCE FEE:** £75.00 per pair to include tea & coffee, 2 course lunch and afternoon tea

**PRIZES:**

**The Open Mixed Foursomes (Scratch)** to the pair with the lowest gross 36 hole score

**The Open Mixed Foursomes (Handicap)** to the pair with the lowest net 36 hole score

Prizes & Vouchers will be presented for the first three places and the best morning and best afternoon scores in the Handicap and Scratch competitions. No pair may win more than one prize.

**SWEEP:** An optional £5.00 team sweep for players aged over 18 may be entered on the day. These will be shared between the top two qualifying aggregate Handicap and Scratch scores.

**TIES:** Ties will be decided on the last 18,9,6,3 or final hole as may be necessary.

**LOCAL RULES:** The Local Rules applicable are as printed on the score card which will be issued on the day. Any changes from and additions to these Local Rules will be notified on the day.

**DISTANCE-MEASURING DEVICES:** For all play at North Hants Golf Club a player may obtain distance information by using a device that measures distance only. If, during a round, a player uses a distance-measuring device that is designed to gauge or measure other conditions that might affect his play (e.g. gradient, wind speed, temperature, etc.) the player is in breach of Rule 14-3, for which the penalty is disqualification, regardless of whether any such additional function is actually used. Penalty for breach of this local rule: disqualification

**DRESS CODE:** Smart casual dress is required in the Clubhouse at all times, this includes golf attire. Golf shoes may not be worn in the lounge or dining room at any time.

**COMMITTEE:** The competition is organised by The Committee of the North Hants Golf Club which will rule on any dispute which may arise and its decision shall be final.
